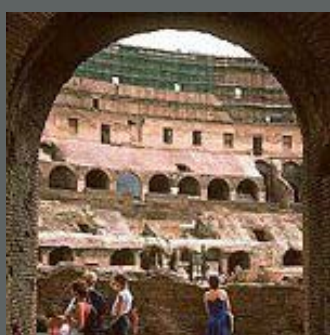

Discussion **Roman Colosseum Commentary**

The Colosseum or Flavian Amphitheater was begun by Vespasian, inaugurated by Titus in 80 A.D. and completed by Domitian. Located on marshy land between the Esquiline and Caelian Hills, it was the first permanent amphitheater to be built in Rome. Its monumental size and grandeur as well as its practical and efficient organization for producing spectacles and controlling the large crowds make it one of the great architectural monuments achieved by the ancient Romans.



The amphitheater is a vast ellipse with tiers of seating for 50,000 spectators around a central elliptical arena. Below the wooden arena floor, there was a complex set of rooms and passageways for wild beasts and other provisions for staging the spectacles. Eighty walls radiate from the arena and support vaults for passageways, stairways and the tiers of seats. At the outer edge circumferential arcades link each level and the stairways between levels.

The three tiers of arcades are faced by three-quarter columns and entablatures, Doric in the first story, Ionic in the second, and Corinthian in the third. Above them is an attic story with Corinthian pilasters and small square window openings in alternate bays. At the top brackets and sockets carry the masts from which the velarium, a canopy for shade, was suspended.

The construction utilized a careful combination of types: concrete for the foundations, travertine for the piers and arcades, tufa infill between piers for the walls of the lower two levels, and brick-faced concrete used for the upper levels and for most of the vaults.

Details

The Colosseum was designed to hold 50,000 spectators, and it had approximately eighty entrances so crowds could arrive and leave easily and quickly.

The plan is a vast ellipse, measuring externally 188 m x 156 m (615 ft x 510 ft), with the base of the building covering about 6 acres. Vaults span between eighty radial walls to support tiers of seating and for passageways and stairs.

The facade of three tiers of arches and an attic story is about 48.5 m (158 ft) tall — roughly equivalent to a 12-15 story building.

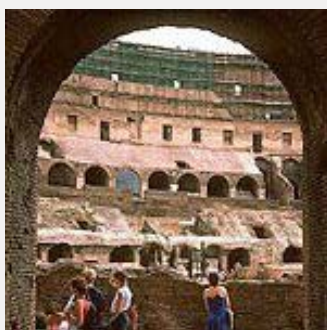

Trevi Fountain

The Fontana di Trevi or Trevi Fountain is the most famous and arguably the most beautiful fountain in all of Rome. This impressive monument dominates the small Trevi square located in the Quirinale district.

Aqua Virgo

The Trevi fountain is at the ending part of the Aqua Virgo, an aqueduct constructed in 19 BC. It brings water all the way from the Salone Springs (approx 20km from Rome) and supplies the fountains in the historic center of Rome with water.

Construction of the Fountain

In 1732, Pope Clement XII commissioned Nicola Salvi to create a large fountain at the Trevi Square. A previous undertaking to build the fountain after a design by Bernini was halted a century earlier after the death of Pope Urban VIII. Salvi based his monumental baroque fountain was finally completed in 1762.

The Fountain

The central figure of the fountain, in front of a large niche, is Neptune, god of the sea. He is riding a chariot in the shape of a shell, pulled by two sea horses. Each sea horse is guided by a Triton. One of the horses is calm and obedient, the other one restive. They symbolize the fluctuating moods of the sea.

On the left hand side of Neptune is a statue representing Abundance, the statue on the right represents Salubrity. Above the sculptures are bas-reliefs, one of them shows Agrippa, the girl after whom the aqueduct was named.

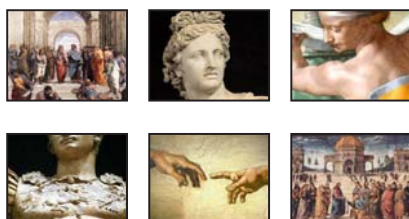

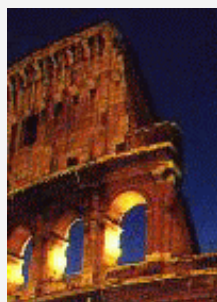

Bellagio is an upscale, elegant hotel, so what better setting for Light, one of Vegas' most sophisticated and opulent nightclubs?

An air of mystery and exclusivity surrounds Light from the moment you approach the line to get in. (If you want to avoid a long wait, get there before 11 p.m.) You can't hear music or see the club from the casino where the line forms.



From the casino, you must take an escalator up a level to reach Light. Once you step off the escalator you still can't see the club. It's only after you walk down a dark, mirrored hallway illuminated by only candlelight that you discover Light.

Light, modeled on the New York nightclub of the same name, is decorated in a combination of wood and deep-red drapery with soft lighting, modern furniture and a moderate-sized dance floor.

All the nightclub tables are reserved and limited to bottle service customers. There are approximately 30 tables, which will accommodate up to 10 people each. There also is a VIP area offering a complete view of the venue.

For those who aren't seated at one of the exclusive tables, there are two full bars to serve your needs. Expect to pay about \$8 for mixed drinks and \$5 for beer.

A good mix of hip-hop and house music keeps the dance floor packed. Light has the Vegas club standard go-go dancers, but here the dancers wear tasteful costumes that cover a bit more skin than at most other clubs.

You'll find a very refined and well-heeled crowd at Light and a wide variety of ages. You might even spot a celebrity or two at this stylish nightspot.

The air of mystery continues when you leave Light. Since the escalators travel only one way up to the club, you must take an elevator, which is hidden at the end of another dark corridor, to go back downstairs to reality.

Rain Las Vegas Review

The pleasures of Rain Las Vegas lie in its contradictions. Like the hotel-casino that hosts it, the club was built for locals but encourages out-of-state visitors to leave the Strip and party down. It is cavernous without feeling impersonal, unique without being gimmicky and elegant without being pretentious.



As you enter the club through a bright, futuristic tunnel, the club's visual charms hit you immediately. The state-of-the-art lighting system washes the room in color and motion, the dance floor seems to float on a bed of fountains and a wall of Strip-facing windows compliment the members-only "cabanas" on the upper level. Burton is a classical magician, dressing in a tuxedo and tails and beginning every show by performing his trademark sleight-of-hand tricks. 'Tournament of Kings' a royal romp

Like the gladiatorial contests at the Coliseum, the cheers of visitors to Excalibur's "Tournament of Kings" can hardly be contained behind the arena walls.

The medieval-themed tournament combines arena-style entertainment with a bacchanalian feast befitting a king.

The show begins with great fanfare as the seven kings and one dragon knight (representing evil), are announced. Their royal costumes are rich in color and design, their horses adorned with bright plumage. (The regalia was designed by Michel Fresnay, who was nominated for a best-costume Emmy in 1989 for the television production of "Napoleon and Josephine".)

The kings then feast with King Arthur at the Round Table, after which a series of games, including a horse race, a jousting match, sword fighting and gladiator-style battles, commence.

Audience members are invited to cheer on the king representing the "country" where they are sitting. Four-rows deep, the arena is divided into seven "country" sections and the "dark knight" section, which represents the evil Mordred's minions. Our seats were in "Russia" - and even though our king played dirty at times, he was very well received.

That's because although the show is a display of physical strength and agility, it relies heavily on audience participation. The toasting ritual enlivens the feast. Guttural chants intensify the jousts and fighting segments. Be aware, however, that you may be reprimanded for booing the opponents too loudly!

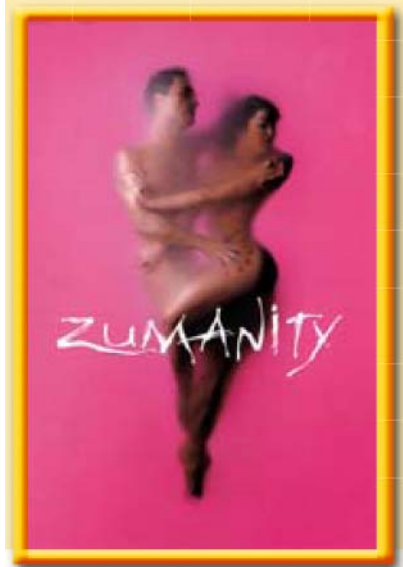
The merriment is interrupted when evil Mordred, the fire wizard, tries to capture King Arthur's kingdom. As the kings come together, one is killed; the others then avenge his death. Each battle is more spectacular than the next, with smoke, fire and pyrotechnics, until the final clash decides a victor.

Dinner is served as the show begins - an appetizer of "dragon's blood" (tomato soup) is followed by a Cornish hen, twice-baked potatoes, broccoli, a roll, soda and dessert. Keeping with the show's medieval theme, no utensils of any kind are given. The meal was cooked to perfection and was quite filling.

The "Tournament of Kings" is a no-holds-barred entertainment rampage - the action is non-stop, battles intense and the crowd frenzied - at times it's impossible to hear anything over the sound of fists banging on tables. It's a raucous good time, one more than worth its price tag.

Show Review

An erotic journey to the other side of Cirque du Soleil

From the moment you enter the Zumanity Theatre at the New York-New York Hotel & Casino, the sense of something "different" surrounds you. A lobby reminiscent of a classic opera house, complete with a winding staircase leading up to balcony seats, creates a sophisticated, alluring feeling. Moving toward the entrance to the theater proper, cushioned walls covered in soft fabric summon you forward, shades of red and blue creating a sensual atmosphere before even being seated.

Inside, the European opera house feeling is reinforced. Unlike other Cirque du Soleil productions, this purpose-built theater -- like Zumanity itself -- does not involve a lot of technical trickery or mechanical constructs. It is intimate and refined, a seemingly simple stage with an extended apron protruding from beneath gorgeous dark red curtains. Winding staircases flank both sides of the stage, leading up to a movable platform for the Zumanity Orchestra -- the interactive house band that provides the live soundtrack for the show.

Well before the show begins, characters appear from all sides, interacting with audience members in their individual, playfully erotic ways. Latin lothario Antonio arouses the interest of women (and some men) with his irresistible gigolo charm, while the lusciously voluptuous Botero Sisters -- in matching risqué ; maid uniforms -- offer fresh strawberries to audience members, managing to squeeze themselves into tightly packed aisles with comical results.

Zumanity begins organically, with the various preshow characters merging on stage with more of the cast, until emcee Joey Arias appears to guide the audience through the show, beginning with a brief introduction to each character as they parade down the catwalk to the fanfare of drums and horns.

Unlike recent Cirque productions, Zumanity makes no attempt at a storyline. In true cabaret style, each act stands alone, the only connecting factor being Arias' narrative songs and jokes. But the elements still come together smoothly, transitions eased by music and subtle set changes.

Despite the warm, sensual atmosphere, Zumanity still features dazzling displays of human capabilities stretched to their limits. Sara Joel and Stéphan Choinière demonstrate amazing strength and balance as they support each other in Kama Sutra-inspired positions. Gyulnara Karaeva and Bolormaa engage in an astonishing display of poise, beauty and skill in and on a giant water bowl. The beautiful Olga Vershinina performs with acrobatic grace high above the stage, suspended only by her own strength and skill upon two lengths of silk.

Zumanity is not all beauty and elegance, however. It also touches on the darker side of eroticism, on the primal urges of our natures and on the topics that much of our society deems "deviant." Tragic beauty Robyn struggles with nylon straps, dangling from the rafters, climaxing in an autoerotic act of ecstasy. Sweet and gorgeous Elena performs an alluring dance on and around a television set to distract her football-focused and neglectful lover. Caged dancers Bernard Giaddis and Kevin Gibbs struggle, cheered on by other prisoners, until they finally embrace in a passionate kiss.

A comedic quartet appears sporadically throughout the proceedings to break up the tension and remind us all that sex should always be -- above all else -- fun. When you boil down the multiple elements of Zumanity, that's really the underlying theme: Though some of the acts present serious images of eroticism, we should never forget that our bodies and our lives are meant for pure pleasure and sheer joy -- and that joy is meant to be shared.

Show Review

A "legend" in its own right

Paying homage to the most enduring stars to ever grace the music scene, "Legends in Concert" has itself become one of the world's hottest tribute shows.

When "Legends in Concert" came to the Imperial Palace in 1983, it was slated for a six-week run, but was held over due to overwhelming response (original tributes included those to Buddy Holly, Janis Joplin, and, of course, Elvis). That response is still strong today, as Legends plays to packed crowds nightly.

Performers continually rotate (check the downstairs ticket counter for the evening's cast), making it possible to see a different show each visit. The night I attended, the line-up included James Brown, Liza Minnelli, Ricky Martin, Madonna, the Temptations and Elvis, which made for quite an energetic mix.

Herbert Rawlings Jr. got it started with James Brown's "I Feel Good." A dead ringer for Brown, Rawlings immediately captured his aura, screaming out to the crowd and dazzling them with his dance moves - including the splits.

What's amazing about Legends is that the impersonators not only are the spitting images of the performers they imitate (and incredibly, most even have the same stature), they sing with their natural voices, a point the Imperial Palace stresses throughout the show.

No performer in the show's cast embodies this more than Melissa Totten as Madonna. In keeping with the Material Girl's constant image overhauls, Totten first appeared on stage with medium-length blonde hair a la Madonna's "Music" album.

You'll do a double take - save the gap in her front teeth, Totten is a carbon copy of the singer in both looks and voice. Totten performs a great cross-section of songs from across Madonna's career, including "Vogue," "Holiday" and a segment from her "Blonde Ambition" tour.

Matt Lewis, however, as Elvis, is the audience favorite. And like the King himself, Lewis gets the crowd worked up, as young and old alike swoon for the dreamy singer. His foray into the audience by way of the showroom's tables was the best-received segment of the night.

Although you may be unfamiliar with some of the stars the show imitates, you'll feel you've been a lifelong fan by the end. Chances are you'll opt to stick around after the show for autographs and pictures with its stars. Just be prepared for a mob scene.

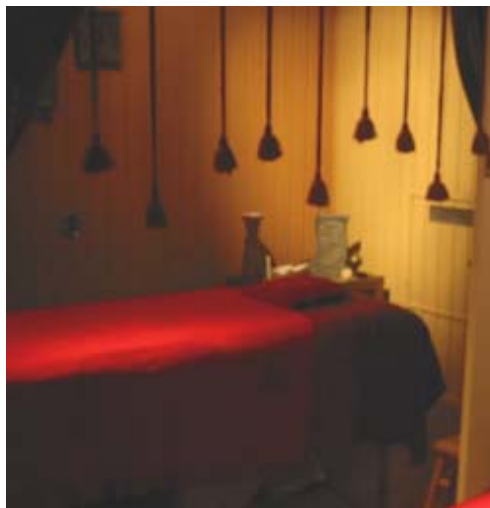

Massage

The basic goal of massage therapy is to help the body heal itself and to increase health and well being. When muscles are overworked, waste products accumulate in the muscle, causing soreness, stiffness, and even muscle spasm.

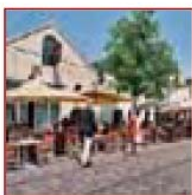

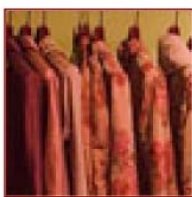
